



A surveillance and monitoring test for the early recurrence of breast cancer.

Early detection of cancer recurrence can save lives.

What is MammoCheck?

Mammocheck is a blood test that measures a specific cancer marker released by breast cancer cells in the blood. **MammoCheck** is an active surveillance test to determine ahead of time if cancer is returning.

How Mammocheck can benefit you?

Performed regularly, **Mammocheck** can relieve your fear of the unexpected while waiting for the next scheduled exam.

How to understand your test results?

A single tube of blood (4ml) is all that is needed. Your doctor will receive the test results. A positive test result indicates a cancer recurrence signal and an increased likelihood of relapse. Your doctor will

consult with you on the next procedure. A negative result indicates a lack of detectable cancer recurrence at the time of the test. Regular testing in the gaps between follow-up visits is **recommended**.

Mammocheck advantages versus other tests?

CA 15.3, the only blood test used in the clinic, detects mostly late-stage breast cancer when metastasis may have already started affecting essential organs.

Mammocheck is an active surveillance test that detects early cancer recurrence when therapeutic measures have greater positive outcomes.
