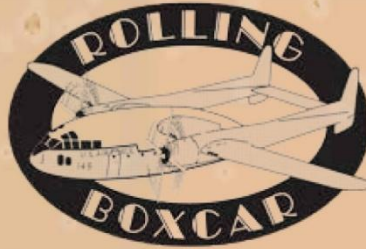

Some time ago we realized that we needed a more permanent base of operations here in Northern California to both build RBC in a more controlled environment and base our southern operations out of.

With the wing center section reconstructed, the subframe prepped with additional axles and their associated braking systems installed and a

large amount of the electrical work done, so Phase Two, mating the fuselage and the frame together, is next. This will have to be done inside and out of the wind and into a more controlled environment.

So, RBC's new "Southern Command" will be in the very small town of Bieber, California, Population 111.

We will be putting up an 80' by 41' steel structure using cargo shipping containers with a steel roof enclosing the "hangar". We have talked to several folks that live in Bieber, and they are excited to have us there. It will be powered completely with solar power so no power bills will be nice.
