- Course placement supported by Kuleana academic advising

About This Partnership Catalog

This catalog presents ASU Prep course options that Kuleana Preparatory Academy may make available to enrolled students through approved partnership pathways. It is designed for families who want a clear view of potential course offerings while still receiving Kuleana advising, progress monitoring, records support, and program oversight.

Course availability, format, credit value, prerequisites, tuition/fees, teacher assignment, grading rules, start dates, and technology access may vary by student program, enrollment date, partner availability, and administrative approval.

Families should confirm final course placement with Kuleana before assuming a course is available or transcript-applicable for a specific student.

How Students Use ASU Prep Courses Through Kuleana

Kuleana may use ASU Prep courses as part of full-time enrollment, flex programming, homeschool support, credit planning, elective expansion, advanced coursework, or college-and-career pathways.

Kuleana supports the family with course selection, pacing guidance, progress check-ins, transcript planning, testing expectations, and communication. ASU Prep course policies, syllabi, assignments, platform requirements, and prerequisites may also apply.

High school students should request advising before selecting courses intended for graduation, NCAA review, college admissions, honors weighting, dual enrollment alignment, or UC/CSU-style planning.

Area	Policy / Guidance
Availability	Course access is subject to partner availability, student eligibility, enrollment timing, prerequisite review, program approval, and account/platform access.
Credit value	Some courses may be full-credit, half-credit, semester, honors, essentials, or elective-only options. Credit value must be confirmed before enrollment.
Prerequisites	Courses such as Geometry, Calculus, second-level languages, and advanced/honors courses may require prior coursework or school approval.
Materials	Fine arts, PE, lab, or performance courses may require instruments, recording tools, supplies, fitness logs, or other materials.
Progress monitoring	Students are expected to log in regularly, complete assignments, communicate with staff, and participate in required assessments or check-ins.
Transcript planning	Kuleana will advise on transcript placement, but course titles, grades, credits, weighting, and college/NCAA applicability require review.

Program changes	Kuleana may modify course access, program format, pricing, support services, or approved course lists due to vendor, staffing, operational, academic, or student-support needs.
