The DON'T WAIT Project® (DWP), founded by Lisa Bradshaw in 2011, is a 501c3 non-profit organization committed to raising community awareness about how positive life choices can impact the health and welfare of individuals, organizations and communities. Since partnering with filmmaker, educator and UnMake a Bully creator Mike Feurstein in 2012, DON'T WAIT to UnMake a Bully™ has worked with more than 8,000 K-12 students at schools throughout the country. Students write, direct, produce and star in anti-bullying PSAs based on their own experience. They use a professional quality film camera and other equipment while learning valuable teamwork and industry skills throughout production.

DAY ONE

90 MINUTES

Anti bullying and character education. Model movie set and job instruction.

2

DAY TWO

90 MINUTES

Students brainstorm and discuss real-life bullying scenarios while writing their PSA script.

3

FILM DAY

ONE SCHOOL DAY

Students film the PSA, fulfilling their chosen jobs, like director, actor, sound and slate.

Bullying Statistics

When being bullied at school

15.4% avoided school.

4.5% were physical when bullied.

85% of time, peers were present.

57% of the time, bullying stops within 10 seconds when bystanders intervene.
