Wisk is a leading Advanced Air Mobility (AAM) company and developer of the world's first self-flying, all-electric, four-seat eVTOL air taxi. Founded in 2010, Wisk is the only company to have designed, built, and flown six generations of eVTOL aircraft. Wisk is fully backed by The Boeing Company but continues to operate separately.

Autonomy

Our aircraft is autonomous, meaning there is no pilot on board. However, we haven't removed humans entirely. Each flight is monitored by a Multi-Vehicle Supervisor (MVSor) from our Fleet Operations Center. The aircraft can aviate, navigate, and communicate on its own and flights proceed according to pre-determined flight plan. The MVSor monitors each flight and can send commands to the aircraft in the event that a flight plan needs to be modified. We believe that autonomy is the key to unlocking increased safety, scalability, and affordability.
