All ponies/horses must be 3 years of age or older, except in classes 5 and 7.

Entries: \$10/Class. Office/Insurance: \$20/pony or horse if we receive entries by 5:00 p.m. Thursday before the show; \$25 after or day of show. Details on entry form. No cattle fees, as we won't use cattle in Trail or Ranch Riding. *High point and reserve rider award* for these divisions: 18&U W/T, 19&O W/T, 18&U W/T/L, and 19&O W/T/L. If showing multiple horses in a class, must specify when you enter which horse to use for points. Must ride in 75% (W/T) or 80% (W/T/L) of age group classes to qualify for high point. Tiebreaker is best placing in Ranch Riding. Also, *high point award* for in-hand horse and for leadline rider. In-hand horse must be shown in both classes 5 and 7, and Leadline rider must show in both classes 6 and 8.
