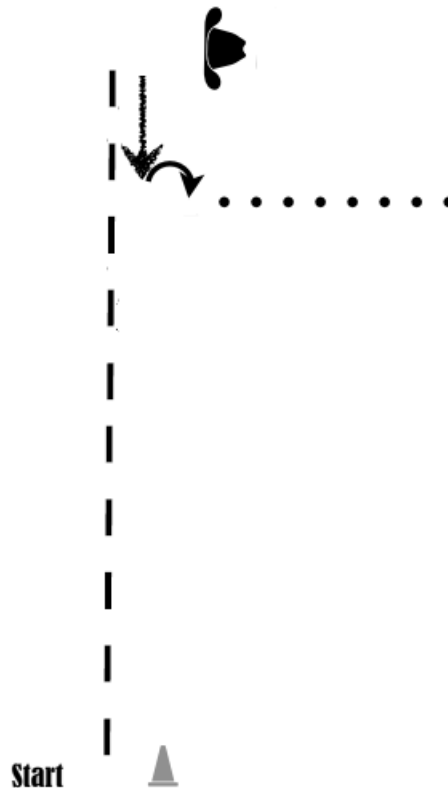


Leadline Showmanship 6&U (Walk Only)

Showmanship 9&U

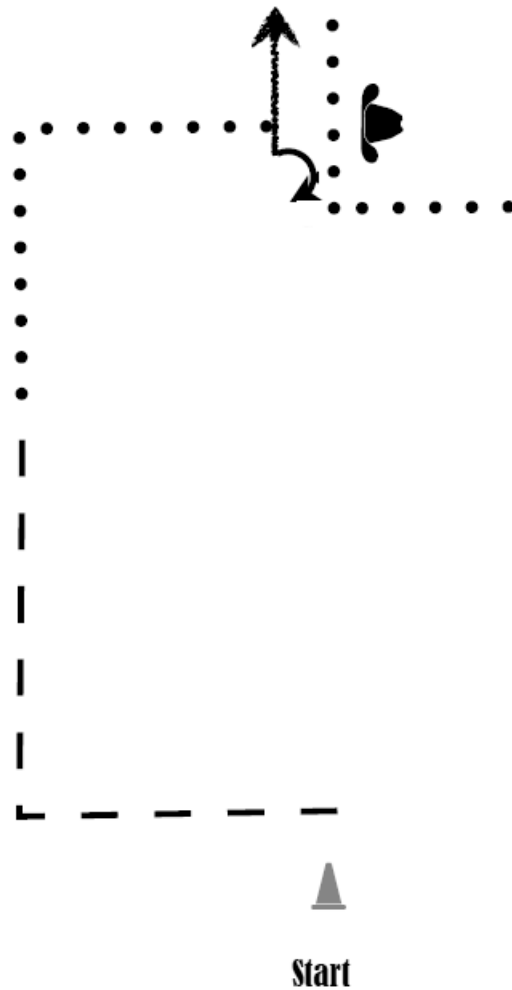


Be ready at cone.

1. Trot until even with judge.
2. Stop and set up for inspection.
3. When dismissed, back at least 4 steps.
4. Perform a 90 degree turn.
5. Walk straight away.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Showmanship 10-13

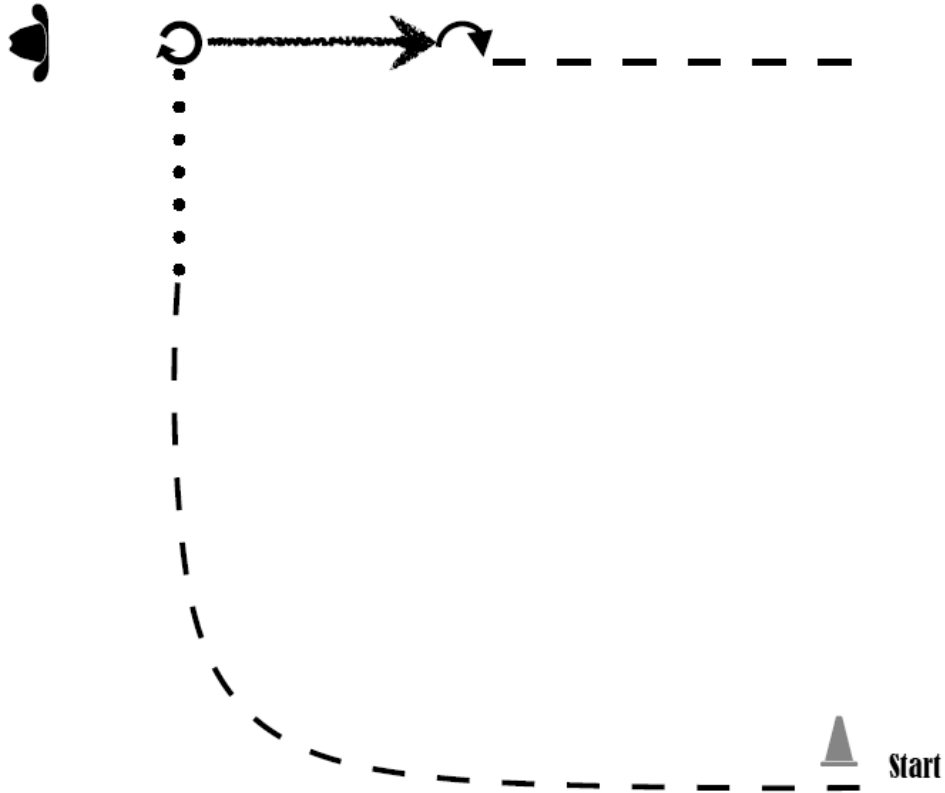


Be ready at cone.

1. Trot, corner, and trot half the line to judge.
2. Slow to walk, corner.
3. Stop at judge and set up for inspection.
4. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn.
5. Back 6-8 steps.
6. Walk forward, corner, then walk straight away.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Showmanship 14-18, 19&O



Be ready at cone.

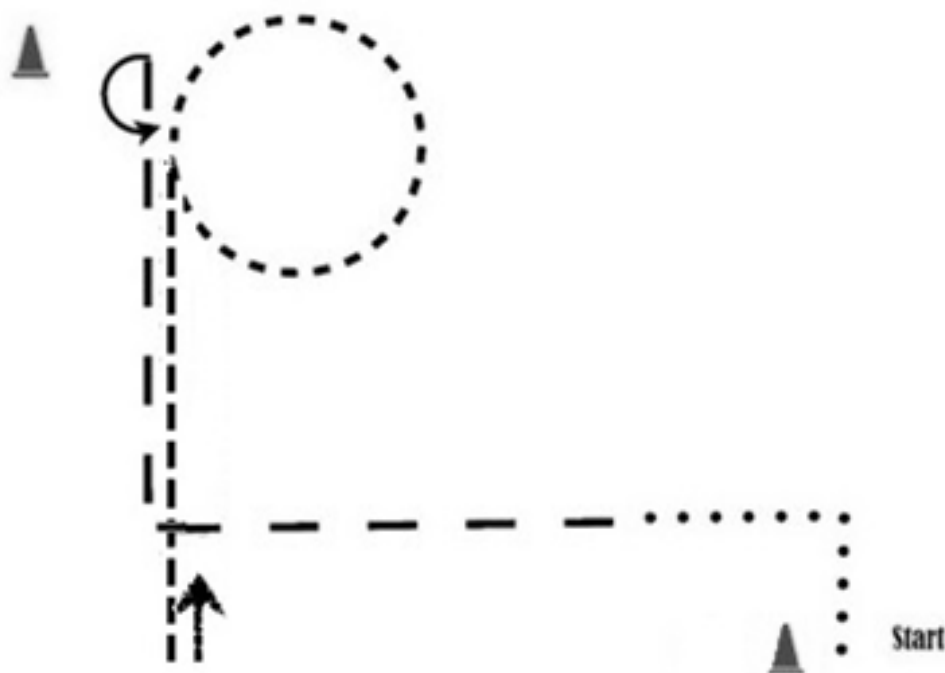
1. Trot in an arc.
2. Slow to walk, and stop when horse's hip is even with judge.
3. Perform a 270 degree turn.
4. Set up for inspection.
5. When dismissed, back 6-8 steps.
6. Perform a 180 degree turn and trot to lineup.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Leadline Horsemanship 6&U (W/J)

(Railwork only, no pattern)

Walk-Trot Western Horsemanship (All Ages) Western Horsemanship 9&U (W/J)

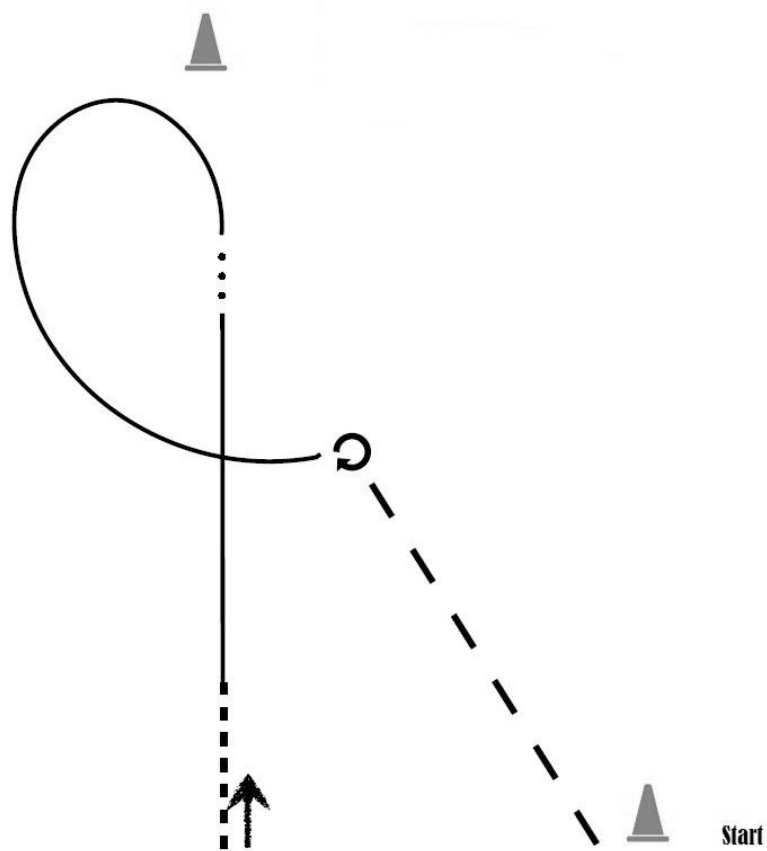


Be ready at cone.

1. Walk, corner.
2. Extended jog, corner.
3. Stop at cone and perform a 180 degree turn to the left.
4. Jog a circle to the left.
5. Continue jogging until even with cone.
6. Stop and back approx. one horse's length.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Western Horsemanship 10-13, 14-18, 19&O



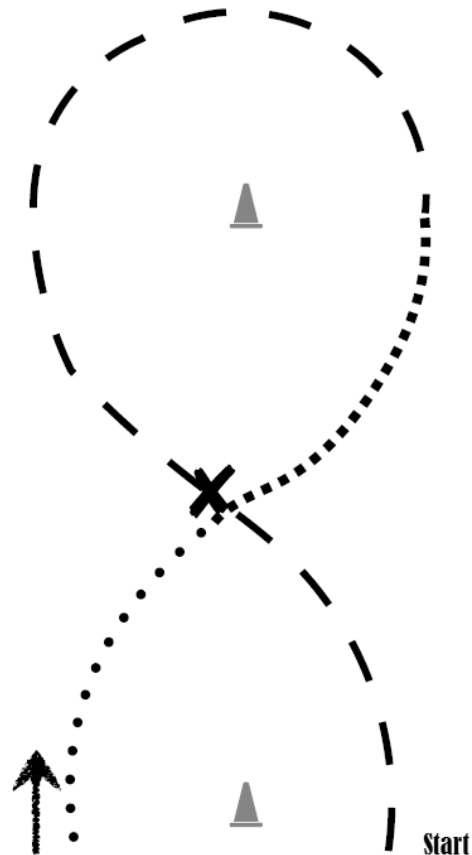
Be ready at cone.

1. Extended jog.
2. Stop in the center of pattern and perform an approx. 270 degree turn to the right.
3. Lope on the right lead.
4. Simple change through the walk.
5. Lope on the left lead.
6. Break to jog.
7. Stop when even with cone and back approx. one horse's length.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Walk-Trot Hunt Seat Equitation (All Ages)

Hunt Seat Equitation 9&U (W/T)

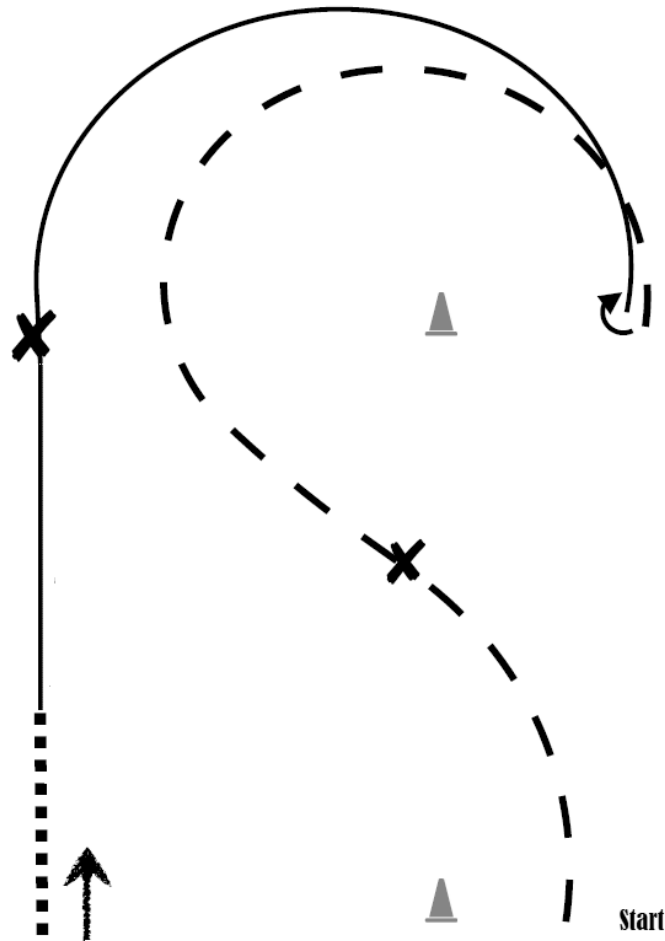


Be ready at cone.

1. Posting trot in an arc on the right diagonal.
2. In the center of the pattern, change diagonals and trot around cone.
3. Sitting trot to center.
4. Break to a walk and walk in an arc to cone.
5. Stop at cone and back one horse's length.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Hunt Seat Equitation 10-13, 14-18, 19&O

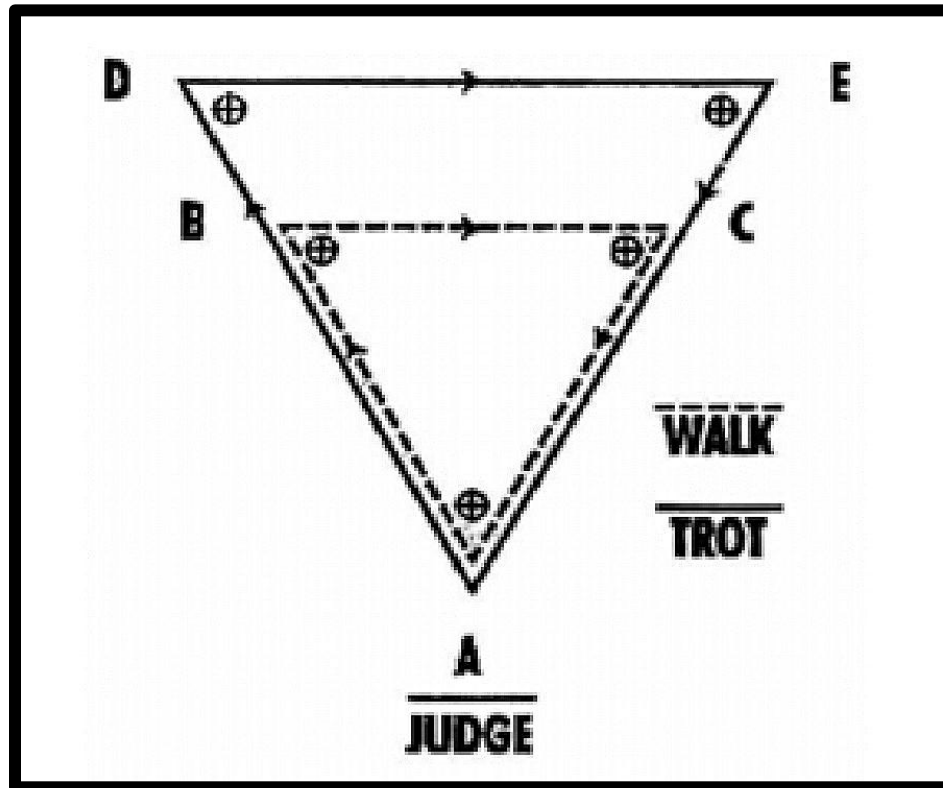


Be ready at cone.

1. Posting trot in an arc on the right diagonal.
2. In the center of the pattern, change diagonals and continue posting trot around cone.
3. Stop and perform a 180 degree turn to the right.
4. Canter left lead a half circle around cone.
5. Change leads and canter right lead past the center of the pattern.
6. Sitting trot until even with cone.
7. Stop and back approx. one horse's length.
8. Exit at a walk.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

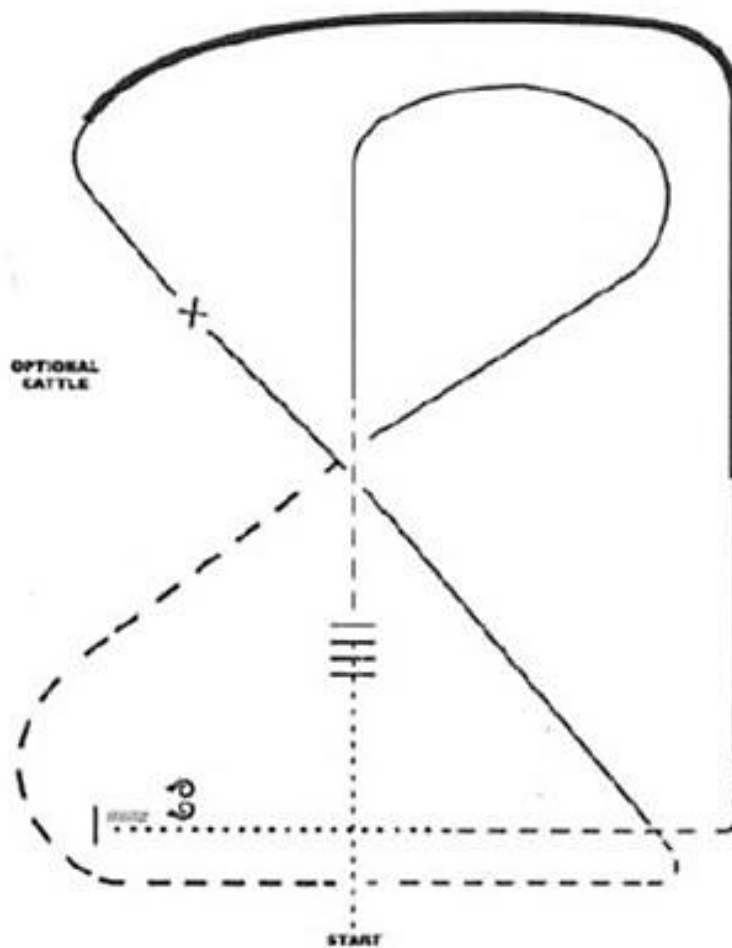
Hunter in Hand 18&U, 19&O



1. Approach the judge and set up for inspection in the “open” position (an offset stance with all four legs visible by the judge standing on either side).
2. At the judge’s request, lead the pony at a walk around the small triangle ABCA.
3. Continue on at a trot around the large triangle ADEA.

Ranch Riding 18&U, 19&O

PATTERN 6



1. Walk
2. Walk over logs
3. Trot
4. Lope right lead
5. Extended trot
6. Trot
7. Lope left lead
8. Change leads (simple or flying)
9. Extended lope right lead
10. Collect lope
11. Trot
12. Walk
13. Stop and back
14. 360 degree turn each direction (L-R or R-L)
