Synopsis: Pregnant female fell from the deck of her residence while under the influence of alcohol and drugs.

Narrative/Details:

On 11/02/2014 at approximately 0141 hours, I received a page from Boulder County dispatch reference a request for emergency medical services at 233 Alpine Drive, Nederland 80466. BCSO Deputy Dan Walter (654) was on scene and requesting a Nederland PD response to an intoxicated, pregnant female who had fallen from a deck at her residence.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Deputy Walter and the spouse of the female victim identified as Matthew E. Green DOB 06/18/1985. Matt stated his spouse, identified as Amber Lynn Green DOB [REDACTED], came home earlier that night extremely intoxicated. Matt said Amber is dealing with a "high risk" pregnancy and is currently taking prescription medications. Specifically, Amber is medicated with Ambien and Sertraline (anti-depressant 100 mg).

I asked Matt to provide a detailed account of the incident. Matt stated the following: Amber left their home at approximately 2140 to 2200 hours the night before. Matt stated Amber was angry at him. She returned at approximately 0120 hours the next morning extremely intoxicated. Matt said Amber admitted to drinking at the Pioneer Inn in Nederland. Matt said Amber told him she "did three lines of Cocaine" and that it was the "best" coke she had ever done. Matt said he told Amber to go to bed.

Matt stated Amber left the room and returned a short time later wearing a dress. Matt said he reminded Amber they were dealing with a high risk pregnancy, told her she was impaired, and asked her not to leave the house. Matt said Amber picked up a knife, left the kitchen, and goes out onto the deck located off the west side of the house.

Matt said Amber attempted to climb off the deck. Matt stated Amber lost her balance and began to fall over the deck railing. Matt said he grabbed her arm, removed the knife from her hand and threw it to the side. Matt said that at no time did Amber threaten him in any way with the knife. Matt stated Amber continued to struggle and went over the railing. Matt said he had hold of her jacket and attempted to pull her up. Matt stated Amber slipped out of her jacket and fell to the ground. Matt immediately called 911 and requested an emergency medical response.

Nederland Volunteer Fire Department EMS arrived on scene and facilitated a helicopter transport for Amber to University Hospital.

I documented the scene by taking photographs. Matt provided me with a victim/witness statement. I measured the drop from the top of the deck railing to the ground and determined it to be 15.6 feet. I also measured the drop from the deck edge to the ground and determined it to be 13.7 feet. BCSO Deputy Dan Walter stated Matt's account of the incident was consistent with what Matt reported to him upon his arrival. The physical evidence at the scene is consistent with Matt's account of the incident. There was nothing to indicate a crime had occurred. Deputy Walter concurred with my assessment.





I, Green, Matthew E. (print name) make this voluntary statement to Officer MANZIONE, who has identified himself as a Peace Officer for the Town of Nederland, Colorado. This statement is made by me freely without hope of benefit, reward, or advantage; absent threats, coercion, promises or deception or any unlawful influence.

At approx. 0100hrs, 3 Nov, my wife Amber Green came home from Pioneer Inn Bar. I could smell alcohol on her and I asked her where she had been. She stated at the bar doing the best lines of coke. She then tried to change clothes in order to go back out. I told her that I would not let her go due to already being impaired and 5 months pregnant. She decided to go out on the upper deck and climb over the rail to leave. I told her that was not smart due to the 15-20ft drop. I held on to her for as long as I could. She eventually slipped out of her jacket and fell the 15-20 ft. to the ground. I called 911 and started running down to her and staid on the line until EMS arrived.
