This letter is to inform you that this case has been set for Arraignment on January 12, 2023 at 8:30AM. This Arraignment will take place at 270 South Tejon Street Colorado Springs, CO 80903 in Courtroom 18.

Arraignment means the entry of a plea.

You have the right to consult with the prosecuting attorney before a plea (disposition) is offered in the case. The Defendant may accept a plea and be sentenced at ANY court event (critical stage). You have the right to be heard by the judge, verbally or by submitting a Victim Impact Statement, when the Defendant accepts a plea agreement. You also have the right to be heard and/or provide a written Victim Impact Statement to the judge when the defendant is sentenced. Please be aware that the Defendant and/or his attorney will see your Victim Impact Statement.

You are not required to attend this hearing unless you receive a separate subpoena. However, if you wish to speak to the judge when the Defendant accepts the plea or is sentenced, you should attend. Please be aware that a request to lower or modify the current bond of the Defendant can be addressed at any hearing. If you are unable to attend this court event, but you would like to be heard by the Court and/or submit a Victim Impact Statement if the Defendant accepts the plea and/or is sentenced, please contact our office immediately. If you plan to attend this Arraignment or you have any questions, please call me at the number given above.

We will send you a notice whenever a critical stage is scheduled in the case. Due to the large caseload of the court system, some hearings may need to be changed or canceled. We will attempt to notify you of changes or cancellations, if we are informed of them in advance.
