Guidelines For Artwork:

- All artwork is to be completed while the child is at school

Entry Guidelines:

- Each entry must include on the back upper right hand corner: **Name, grade, teacher, and school**

Judging:

This year we are asking all schools NOT to hang/display the artwork. Instead, we will be picking up the artwork and returning it after it has been judged. **No judging will take place at the school.**
