#### **Entry Guidelines:**

Each entry must include on the <u>back upper right hand corner</u>: Name, grade, teacher, and school

#### Judging:

- Like last year, we are asking all schools NOT to hang/display the artwork. Instead, we will be picking up the artwork and returning it after it has been judged. **No judging will take place at the school.**
- Please have all artwork grouped together by grade and ready to be picked up from your school's office by the deadline below.

Contest entries will be picked up: Thursday, March 10, 2022.
