

Wilson Tactical Operations and Training, LLC. Concealed Weapons Safety Course

Welcome to Wilson Tactical Operations and Training, LLC., Concealed Weapons Safety Course! This course is an 8-hour course that follows proper guidelines. This course consists of understanding the knowledge of the pistol, proper firearm techniques, proper care for the pistol, proper stance, grip and sighting of firearm, current law, child safety and more. (You may also contact for our 4-hour CCW Renewal Course).

Course Pre-Requisites:

- Must have a valid California driver's license or identification card.
- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Possess a firearm in your name that will be placed on your certificate of completion. (If you do not possess a firearm, you will not pass this course however, we do offer a Firearm Safety Course for purchase of firearms).

Course Outline:

This course consists of some lecture, with hands on instruction. The shooter will gain insight in firearm safety and how to properly manipulate their firearm of choice. Shooters will be provided the opportunity to handle such firearms in a controlled setting to gain insight on how the manipulation and safe handling drills will work. This course will consist of stance work, grip work, slight alignment and sight picture, malfunction clearing and more. You will be provided a certificate of completion at the end of the course after passing the qualification course for each firearm you wish to carry. This is not an entry level course and the shooter should have some working knowledge of their firearm. (If you are looking for an entry level course prior to taking this course, refer to our Basic Tactical Firearms Course).

Time:

- The 8-hour course will begin at 0800 hours and end at 1600 hours.
- The 4-hour course will begin at 0800 hours and end at 1200 hours.

- A minimum of 150 rounds of ammunition (May exceed the amount of wanting extra repetitions during the training)
- Quality holster that will be utilized how you will carry

- More than one magazine (If you have a magazine holster, you may bring to class)

- Shooters will be expected to follow the dress code. Closed-toe shoes, pants, a t-shirt (No offensive or obscene content), eyewear, ear protection and a hat if desired.
