Day 1 – Tuesday, September 29, 2026

Day 3 – Thursday, October 1, 2026: Manitoulin Island

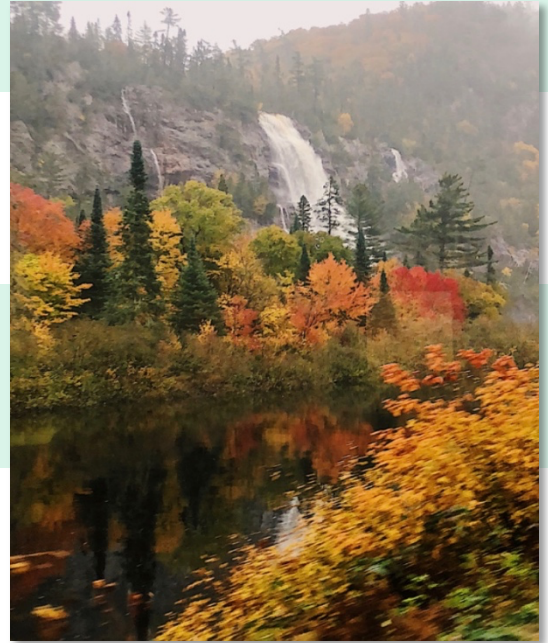
