Day One | Depart Canada

Today, we depart Canada for our overnight flight from Ottawa Airport to Dublin, picks ups will take place along Highway 417.

Day Two | Arrive in Glasgow

Welcome to Scotland! You will meet your tour guide at the airport and make your way to Glasgow for a city tour. There will also be time to visit the extensive and varied art collections in Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum. Tonight, we enjoy a welcome dinner at our hotel.

Day Three | Burns Country

Depart for Robbie Burns Country, where the first stop of the day is Burns National Heritage Park. The museum is the focal point of this beautifully landscaped park where visitors can cross the Brig o'Doon and visit the poet's birthplace. Later, continue to Culzean Castle in Ayrshire.

First on today's agenda is a guided tour of one of Belfast's most iconic buildings, Belfast City Hall. Tonight, you may wish to dine in Belfast's Cathedral Quarter, a vibrant part of town that is known for its fabulous restaurants, bistros, and pubs.

Day Eleven | Giant's Causeway

Then we visit Belleek, home of the world-famous porcelain where we can see craftsmen hard at work. We enter the romantic domain of W.B. Yeats where we will see sites associated with the poet before arriving in Westport. There will be time to refresh and unwind before enjoy dinner at our hotel.
