Day 1: Tuesday, September 28, 2027 Overnight Flight

Discover a dramatic waterway where winding valleys give way to riverside cities and Alpine hamlets. Venture along the Rhine and Moselle and spend time in beloved European cities, getting a taste of the local culture at each stop along the way.

Day 2: Wednesday, September 29, 2027 Amsterdam, Netherlands - Board Cruise Ship

Arrive in Amsterdam,* the 800-year-old capital of the Netherlands, a city of narrow canals and stone bridges. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. For those arriving earlier in the day, you may relax in the ship's lounge and enjoy refreshments until your cabin is ready in the late afternoon. Or, if you're ready to explore, consider visiting one of Amsterdam's famed museums, such as the Van Gogh Museum** or the Anne Frank House.** This evening, meet in the lounge for a cocktail reception followed by a welcome aboard dinner. (D)

Day 3: Thursday, September 30, 2027 Amsterdam

Begin your day with a canal cruise led by a local expert, experiencing Amsterdam from a unique perspective as you glide along the city's centuries-old canal system. Sail by charming cafés and famous 16th-century row houses stacked side-by-side. Once your tour concludes in the late morning, spend some time exploring the city however you wish. Perhaps you'll stroll through the charming Jordaan district, or soak in the atmosphere at a canal-side café. This afternoon, relax as your ship departs the Netherlands and makes its way to Germany. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Friday, October 1, 2027 Cologne, Germany

As the sun rises, glide along the Rhine River and pass through picturesque German landscapes dotted with medieval towns. Your journey brings you to Cologne, where you will join a guide for a walking tour of the city's Gothic Old Town. Wander along cobblestone streets and admire the Cologne Cathedral, the Roman Dionysus mosaic, and the Romanesque church of St. Martin. Top off this walking tour with a tasting of Cologne's famous Kölsch beer, before enjoying some free time this afternoon in this magnificent city. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Saturday, October 2, 2027 Winningen - Cochem - Winningen***

Start your morning by travelling by coach to Cochem, a storybook town overlooking the water. Embark on a guided tour through the town and into Reichsburg Castle,**** a fortress perched high upon a hill with a stunning view of Cochem and the Moselle Valley below. Rejoin your ship in Winningen to spend a scenic afternoon and evening sailing along the Rhine and through the Lorelei Passage, the river's narrowest point, named for a storied siren. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sunday, October 3, 2027 Speyer

The river takes you to Speyer, one of Germany's oldest cities, where **it's your choice!** Get to know Speyer on a walking tour where you'll trace the story of Speyer's Jewish community from the year 1084 to today, visiting significant UNESCO sites -OR-

follow guides on a journey back in time to discover the everyday lives of citizens in the Middle Ages. Spend the afternoon as you wish, perhaps joining an optional excursion to Heidelberg, an ancient city of Renaissance buildings and castle ramparts. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Monday, October 4, 2027 Strasbourg, France

Cross the French border and experience Strasbourg, a fairytale town that blends centuries of international influences to create its own unique culture. On a guided walking tour through the old quarter and a canal cruise along *Petite France*, take in the iconic timber-framed houses, the Cathedral of Notre Dame, and Place de la République. Make the most of your free time in the afternoon by exploring this perfectly preserved town. Aboard the ship, toast to the end of a fabulous journey at your farewell dinner. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tuesday, October 5, 2027 Breisach, Germany - Freiburg - Breisach

This morning, arrive back in Germany and travel by coach to Freiburg, the capital of the Black Forest region. Enjoy a guided tour through Freiburg's beautifully preserved medieval Old Town set against the stunning backdrop of the Black Forest. Then return to Breisach, one of the oldest towns in the country, and spend the afternoon strolling through its picturesque alleys and colourful market square. Perhaps you'll visit one of the town's many cafés or ice cream shops before your ship departs for Basel. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wednesday, October 6, 2027 Basel, Switzerland - Disembark Ship - Bern - Zermatt

Your time on tour comes to a close today, but there's more of the world to see. Now it's off to make new memories. Disembark your cruise in Basel and travel to the Swiss capital of Bern. Explore delightful Bern on a panoramic sightseeing tour, led by a local guide, passing by the Bundeshaus (the Swiss Parliament), the famous Bear Pit, the Rose Gardens and the Gothic cathedral which dominates Old Town's skyline. Complete your day in the unique, car-less village of Zermatt. (B, D)

Day 10: Thursday, October 7, 2027 Zermatt

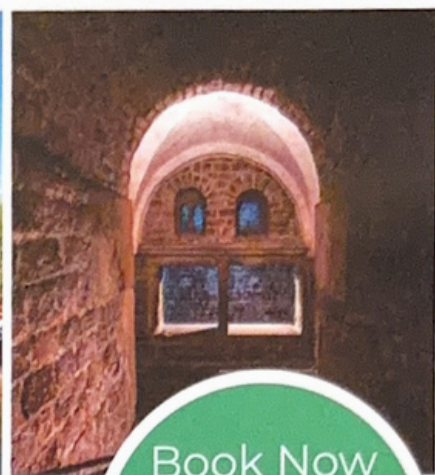
Start your morning by joining a walk with your Tour Manager to get familiar with the quaint mountain village of Zermatt. Later, embrace the breathtaking scenery aboard the Gornergrat Railway,* climbing to panoramic viewpoints that offer unforgettable vistas of the Matterhorn and surrounding alpine peaks. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy Zermatt at your leisure. (B)

Day 11: Friday, October 8, 2027 Zermatt - Zürich

Depart Zermatt and journey to Zürich. Upon arrival, enjoy free time to explore the city independently — perhaps strolling along Lake Zürich, browsing the Old Town, or relaxing at a café. This evening, gather with your fellow travellers for a farewell dinner and raise a glass to the memories made along the way. (B, D)

Day 12: Saturday, October 9, 2027 Zürich - Extension Ends

Your scenic journey comes to an end today in Zürich. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travellers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with a maximum of four groups of 44 travellers onboard this river cruise itinerary.

During the walking tours in Cologne and Strasbourg, expect to navigate cobblestone streets and uneven grounds covering a walking distance of around two miles (around 3.2 kilometers). You should also be prepared to stand for longer periods of time, up to three hours.

****In Cochem, the expected length of the walking tour is approximately 2.5 miles navigating through cobblestone streets on your way to

Reichsburg Castle. To access the castle, there is a shuttle bus available to take you to the lower entrance, from where there's an entrance ramp to walk up. There are no elevators available.

In Amsterdam and Strasbourg, be prepared for climbing in/out of a canal boat, which requires agility.

*As there is no portage service at Amsterdam airport, you are required to handle your luggage from the terminal to the luggage truck on your arrival day. The walking distance between the luggage truck and the motorcoach is approximately one quarter of a mile. Departing Zurich airport, you'll be responsible for handling your own luggage from the motorcoach to the departures terminal.

While this tour is appropriate for travellers that require some mobility assistance devices, river cruises cannot accommodate travellers on wheelchairs or with restricted mobility due to gangway access, mooring requirements, and lack of elevator accessibility to every deck of the ship.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

*****The driving distance from Basel to Zurich is 54 miles/87 kilometers and expected travelling time is 1.5 hours depending on traffic.

In Speyer and Strasbourg, depending on the docking position, the ship may not be docked within walking distance of the old city.

While the ship is the primary mode of transportation on this tour, some daily excursions may use coaches, depending on the docking position.

***Winningen is only used as a docking place for the Cochem visit.

Due to city regulations in Amsterdam, tour coaches have restricted access. Designated drop-off and pick-up points are located approximately 2 miles/3 kilometers from the city centre, requiring a walk through the picturesque streets.

Ports of call are subject to change based on pier availability and weather conditions.

This itinerary is subject to change due to unforeseen changes in water levels, delays at the locks, and other circumstances that may arise along the waterways. These changes may include items being missed during the tour; however, every effort will be made to substitute another attraction if possible.

Smart casual wear is recommended throughout the tour. For the welcome and farewell dinners, a dinner dress for ladies and jacket and tie for gentlemen are recommended. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended throughout the tour.

Coffee or tea is included with all meals. Wine, beer, and soda are included with each dinner onboard the ship.

**The Van Gogh Museum and the Anne Frank House are the 2 most popular sites in Amsterdam. Tickets are in high demand and are difficult to obtain on the day or close to the day of visit. If you are interested, we recommend that you purchase tickets online in advance through the museums official websites.

Cabins are available on Main (Ariane), Middle (Alexia), and Upper (Amalia) decks. River cruises are smaller ships and only have a limited number of each cabin category available. Specific categories are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin choice at the time of reservation, however, if that cabin category is no longer available, the closest available category will be offered. Please enquire through our Client Care Centre for any upgrade fees which will apply for different cabin categories. Upgrades are available from Lower to Stateroom, Deluxe Stateroom, and Suite. All cabin upgrades are available on the Amalia and Alexia Decks. The Ariane Deck is connected to the Alexia Deck by 12 steps, and there is no elevator access to this deck. Suites are very limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

On day 2, embarkation begins at 9:00 a.m. A coffee and tea station is available upon arrival, a light lunch service is available at noon, and cabins are available after 3:00 p.m. On day 9, disembarkation is by 9:00 a.m. at the latest.

Single accommodations are extremely limited. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple and child accommodations are not available.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our transfers will depart from Amsterdam, Netherlands airport and return to Zurich, Switzerland airport.

Air travellers will arrive into Amsterdam, Netherlands airport and depart from Zurich, Switzerland airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Return flights should not be booked prior to 11:00 a.m.

The cruise line reserves the right to charge a supplemental fuel charge. Should this charge be incurred, you will be notified in advance.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Gratuities for cabin stewards, bus boys, cruise manager, and waitstaff on board the ship are not included and are at your discretion.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more travelling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Documentation is required by foreign governments for all trips outside Canada. You should visit Global Affairs Canada at <https://travel.gc.ca/> for general information about passports and visa requirements. Some countries require a visa in addition to a valid passport for entry, so it is important that you check with the appropriate foreign consulate or embassy for specific entry requirements and details you need to know regarding how and when to obtain the visa. Please remember the possession of valid passports and necessary visas are the responsibility of each traveller. If you would like assistance in ensuring you have the proper visa(s) for your trip outside of Canada, we would be happy to refer you to a company that can assist you.

We strongly recommend that you have a valid passport (with seven-month validity) for all travel outside Canada.

Please be advised transit visas may be required if connecting through a country on route to your final destination.

INSURANCE

When travelling outside Canada, health insurance is required. Contact your booking agent for more details.

TRAVEL CONDITIONS

There may be different living standards and practices and different standards and conditions with respect to the provision of services and accommodations outside of Canada.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

ETIAS visa waiver requirements are anticipated to begin during the last quarter of 2026, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. To identify Schengen Area Countries and to complete the ETIAS application, please visit https://travel-europe.europa.eu/etias_en

A deposit of \$898 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the seat reduction date of September 22, 2026 are based upon availability. Final payment due by May 31, 2027. Deposits are refundable up until September 29, 2026.
