THRUST OF THE TEXT: Jesus gives us His Spirit to Secure Sufferers.

Jesus secures sufferers by:

- I. Sending the Spirit to convict the world (vv.1-11)
- a. Concerning sin (vv.8-9)
- b. Concerning righteousness (vv.8, 10)
- c. Concerning judgement (vv.8, 11)
