John 15:1-11

MAIN POINT: You are to forever rely on Jesus like a branch in a vine.

Your life should rely on Jesus:

- I. For His Fruit to be Your Fruit (vv.1-8)
 - a. Confident in prayer (v.7)
 - b. Assured of salvation (v.8)

Judgement in verse 6:

- 1-He's thrown away like a branch (v.6)
- 2-He withers
- 3-Gathered & thrown into the fire
- 4-Burned
