



A Ceasing of the Wealth Chasers

Ecclesiastes 5:8–6:9

Chasing riches is meaningless because:

- I. Money is NOT satisfying (5:10-17)**
 - a. More money, more mouths to feed (v.11)**
 - b. More money, less sleep (v.12)**
 - c. More money, for a little while (vv.13-14)**
 - d. More money, more stress (v.17)**

- II. God's gifts are satisfying (5:18-20)**
 - a. Enjoy the little things (v.18)**
 - b. Accept your situation (v.19)**
 - c. Have Joy in the present (v.20)**
