

Why Should You Listen to Your Parents?

Text: Ephesians 6:1-3

- 1. Because of Who God is (vv. 1-2)**
- 2. Because of What God says (vv. 1-2)**
- 3. Because of What God gives (vv. 1-2)**

Q1: What was your main takeaway from the sermon/text that was preached?
