Main Point: Jesus challenges what kind of belief you have in him.

- I. Jesus rejects belief based solely on what He gives.
(vv.43-50a)**
- II. Jesus accepts belief based on trust in his word
(v.50b)**
- III. Jesus will vindicate our belief in the age to come
(vv. 51-54)**
