John 6:34-40

I. God is sovereign over the salvation of sinners. (vv.35-37)

- a. The invitation of the Gospel is universal (v.35)**
- b. Those given—by the Father, to the son—will be saved (vv.36-37a)**
- d. The Son will not turn away anyone who comes to Him (v.37b)**

II. God is sovereign over the security of the saints. (vv.38-40)
