Main Point: Your love for the praise of men is unbelief growing in your heart.

- I. Your Unbelief scoffs at Jesus claims (vv.1-9)
- II. You Unbelief steals Glory from Jesus' identity (vv.10-18)
- III. Your Unbelief stands on self-righteousness (vv.19-24
