General Rules:

1. Read all rules governing the Otsego County Fair.
2. All educational projects will be evaluated by judges on entry day. Youth will talk with judges during the evaluation.
3. Any article which has been entered in a previous year is not eligible to enter again.
4. Entries in the educational department must have been completed since last year's fair.
5. All entries must have been made by the exhibitor.
6. Entries not properly entered will be disqualified.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for properly placing entry tags securely on their entries.
8. Articles stained or soiled will be disqualified.
9. Exhibits in this department must be of the educational nature.
10. Names are not allowed on projects, or they will be disqualified. Projects with grades, comments, or names visible will be disqualified.
11. Posters must be done on foam core poster board.
12. Displays can be any size.
13. Only one project per class number.

Judging Criteria: Will be based on creativity, neatness, appropriateness of materials used, appearance and workmanship
