General Rules for the following: Ceramics, crafts, scrap booking, rubber stamping, woodworking, painting, sketching, creative writing and sculpture

- 1. Read all rules governing the Otsego County Fair. They must be followed in addition to these general rules.
- 2. All fine arts will be evaluated by judges on entry day. Youth will talk with judges during the evaluation.
- 3. All entries in the fine arts department must have been made by the exhibitor.
- 4. Entries not properly entered will be disqualified.
- 5. Exhibitors are responsible for properly placing entry tags securely on their entries.
- 6. Any article which has been entered in the fine arts department in a previous year is not eligible to enter again.
- 7. Entries must have been completed since last year's fair.
- 8. Articles stained or soiled will be disqualified.
- 9. All wall hanging must be ready for hanging.
- 10. Projects with grades and comments visible will be disqualified.
- 11. Names are not allowed on projects or they will be disqualified.
- 12. All projects must be created from scratch and be original work, NO packaged kits.
- 13. Only one item per class number.

Judging Criteria for ceramics, crafts, painting, sketching, creative writing and sculpture: Workmanship, creativity, neatness, appearance and appropriateness of material used
