3. Exhibits in this department must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. **Exhibitor must provide a vase for their exhibit.**
5. Entries not properly entered will be disqualified.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for properly placing entry tags securely on their entries.
7. Single flower means one blossom, no buds.
8. Only one item per class number.

Judging Criteria:

Cut Flowers: Form, color, substance, stem and foliage size

Potted Plants: Color, condition, stem, foliage size and knowledge of exhibit
