- 2. All horticulture will be evaluated by judges on entry day. Youth will talk with judges during the evaluation.
- 3. All entries in this department must have been grown during the current year.
- 4. Exhibits in this department must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 5. Vegetables can be displayed on a plastic or Styrofoam plate.
- 6. Entries not properly entered will be disqualified.
- 7. Exhibitors are responsible for properly placing entry tags securely on their entries.
- 8. Only one item per class number.
- 9. For more gardening projects see Youth Educational Gardening, Department 72, Sections 007-009.

### Judging Criteria:

Judges will look for the following freedom from roughness, trueness to type, freshness, cleanliness, trimming, size, shape, color and maturity. For more information on "Selecting Vegetables for Exhibit" please contact the MSU Extension Office for a copy of bulletin 4-H 1175. The judge will use this bulletin for judging.
