



Tunisia Hospitality Rider

While Tunisia never wants to be a problematic or demanding group, the necessity of making the band comfortable prior to, during, and following the show, allows the band to perform at its peak and the client to get the show that they are expecting.

1. A private dressing/greenroom for the band to get dressed and prepared for the upcoming show. The room will need to accommodate 12 people with seating for each. The room should be equipped with water and soft drinks for each person. As some venues do not have the ability to provide a private dressing room, the responsibility of the client and/or buyer is to provide a suitable area for the band to be. If there is not a private dressing room and we are using a substitute, notice and approval must be made by Tunisia and deemed suitable.
2. 24 bottles of cold water on or near the stage, placed prior to the start of the show.
3. 1 meal or buyout of a meal for each band and crew member on all shows. This applies to all events unless otherwise agreed and stated in the client contract.
4. Stated in the contract is a clause stating the conditions of hiring the band. The band is to be deemed as a guest or Artist and at no time to be considered a "Vendor". Fall into a vendor category or be treated as such. Please keep in mind that the band is a feature of your event and will be a large part of the success or failure of the event. If we feel like "The Help" it will be difficult to perform at the expected level.
