Close the chapters of this year, embrace the next, allow it's many blessings and surprises to flow into your life.



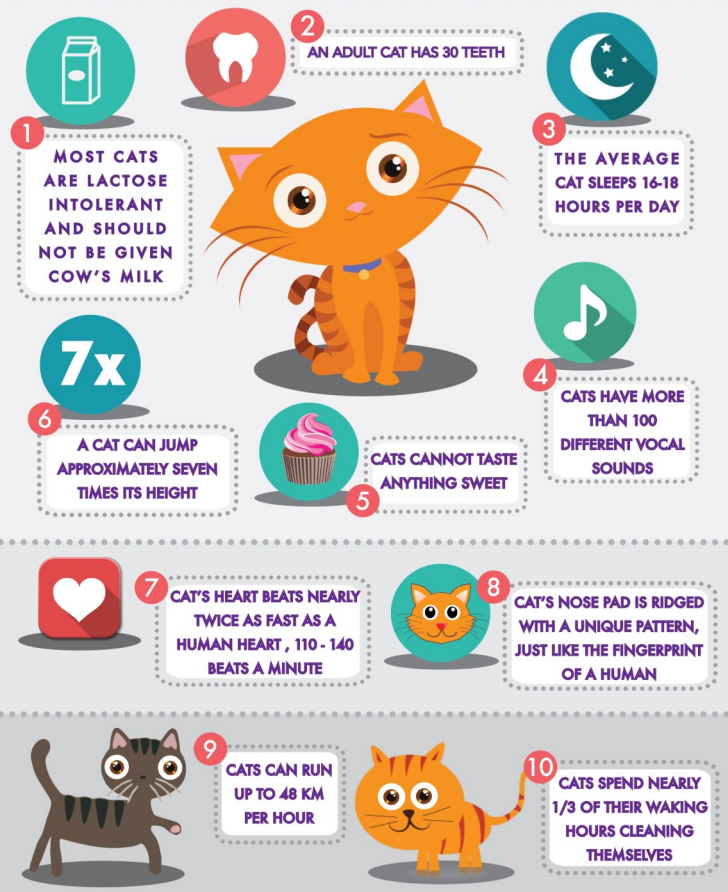
