



What I have to tell is a little bit about a dog named Card; well not really, that was his nick name. Maybe he was called Card because it would have been easier for him to learn to respond to this short name rather than his real, or given name. He was a smart dog though; I'm sure he could have learned a longer name in short order. So, then again, maybe he was called Card, simply because it was more convenient for those who would be calling him, talking to him or when talking about him with others. Who knows?

O.K., You've heard, read about, or saw in the movies about a baby showing up on doorsteps, usually in a basket for whatever reason; this is the way Card showed up. There he was, no more than a couple of months old, looking up and wagging his tail at a friend of mine. There was a note tied to him; it gave his name, and his nick name--Card. It was who Card was.




