To Friends of Rendezvous Pointe,

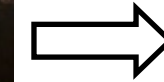

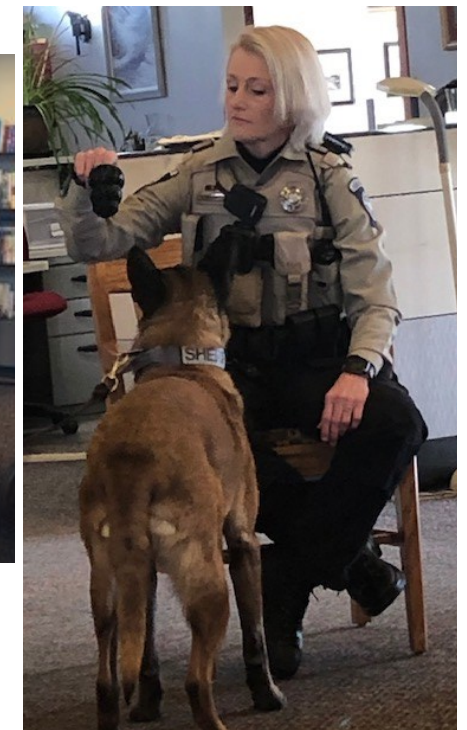

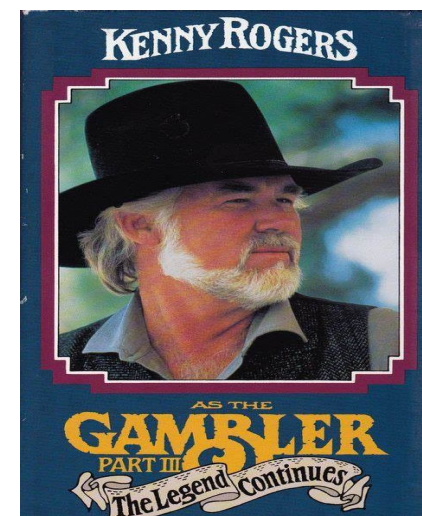

Each outing will require a short walk



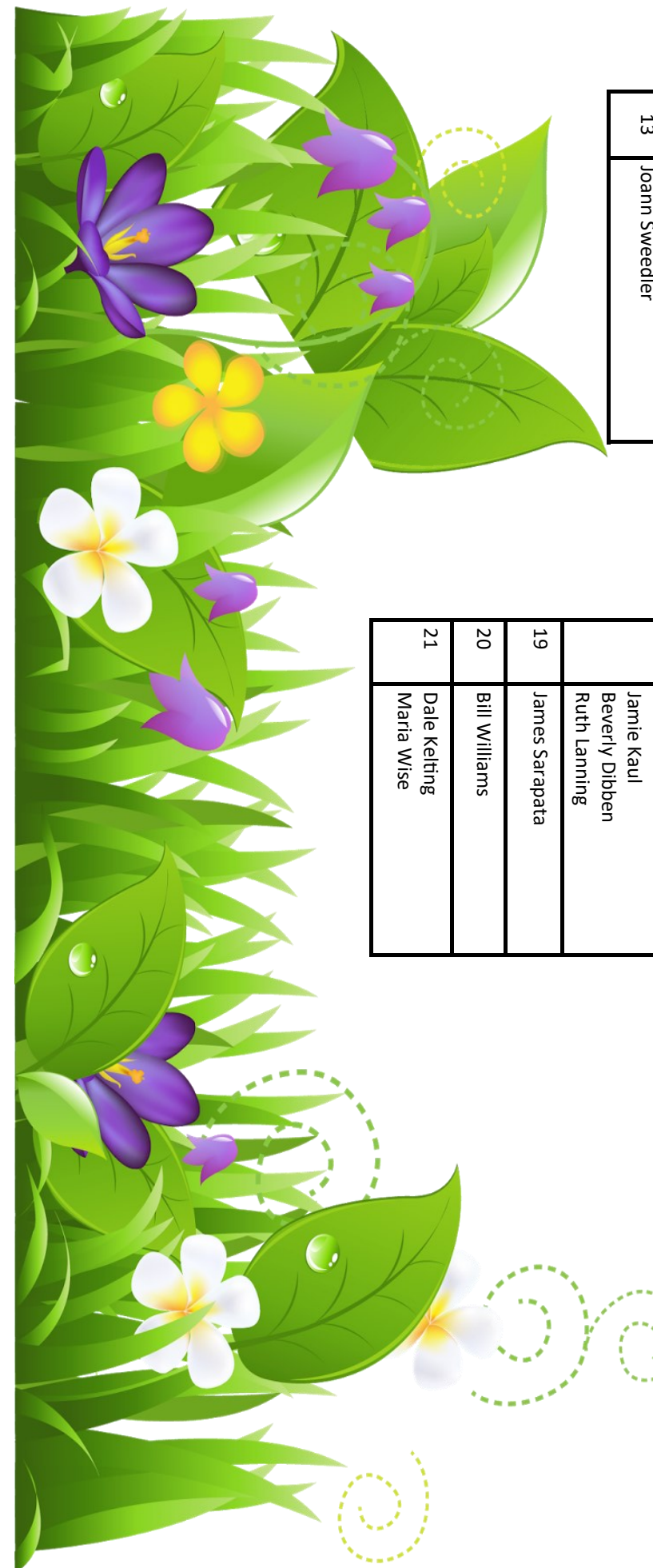
