#### Things You Should Know about **Breast Cancer**





#### What are the statistics?

- 1 in 8 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime
- 30% of all new female cancers diagnosed
- each year are breast cancer

  There are over 2.6 million female breast cancer survivors in the US



#### What is it?

- It is a type of cancer that starts in the breast when cells begin to grow out of control
- Not all breast cancer is the same there are several types of breast cancer depending on where it is in the breast and the specific cells that become cancerous



#### Who does it affect?

- Breast cancer occurs almost entirely in women, but men can get breast cancer, too
- The median age of diagnosis is age 62
- The majority of female breast cancer risk is established during the years between puberty and menopause



#### What about prevention?

- The most common sign and symptom is a new lump or mass
- Screening mammograms, clinical breast exams, and breast self exams can detect early stage breast cancer before signs and symptoms appear



#### What are treatment options?

- If you are diagnosed with breast cancer, treatment is based on the stage and type of your cancer
- Common treatment plans include radiation therapy, surgery, or chemotherapy







# 5 PHYSICAL THERAPY



#### **Eliminate Pain**

It is important to talk with your doctor to develop a physical therapy program that is right for you. Physical therapy can help reduce or eliminate pain altogether.

#### **Improve Mobility**

Patients who have difficulty walking, standing, or moving can benefit greatly from physical therapy. Therapeutic exercises may also eliminate the need for a walking device.



#### **Stroke Recovery**

While a stroke can leave a person partially paralyzed or immobile, a strict physical therapy regimen can help a patient regain their strength.

#### **Sports Recovery**

Although pain medication can provide immediate relief for an athlete suffering from an injury, physical therapy is more effective at providing long-term relief.





In some cases, physical therapy can replace a patient's need for surgery. Even if you are still in need of surgery, physical therapy can give you the strength you need to prepare for the procedure.


