WHO BENEFITS FROM MICHIGAN LOTTERY?

Every time you play the lottery, it's a win for Michigan. Each purchase benefits K-12 education, local businesses, and companies that employ Michigan residents.

Michigan Lottery contributed almost 1.25 billion to the state of Michigan School Aid Fund in fiscal year 2022.

For every \$1 spent on Lottery 63 cents goes to prizes, 25 cents goes to the School Aid Fund, 9 cents goes to retailer and vendor commissions, and 3 cents is used for Lottery operations.

About 10,500 businesses throughout Michigan earn commissions on the sale of Lottery products as licensed retailers. Lottery sales provide a year-round revenue stream for small and large businesses alike. In the last decade, more than \$2.6 billion in sales commissions and bonuses have been paid to these businesses.


All profits from the sale of Michigan Lottery tickets - more than \$27 billion since 1972 - go to the School Aid Fund. We are proud to support the education of Michigan's children, which is our primary mission.





Helping Schools

- Lottery provided \$1.248 billion for public education in the 2022 fiscal year.
- That works out to a contribution of over \$3.4 million each day for schools.
- Michigan K-12 public schools serve more than 1.4 million children. Funding provided by Michigan Lottery is around \$880 per K-12 student.



Helping Players

- Over \$3 billion in prizes paid to players in FY22.
- Last year, Lottery had 53 millionaire prize winners every year.
- Last year, players won a statewide average of almost \$8.6 million a day in prizes.
- Over 124 million winning tickets were validated and paid in FY22.



Helping Retailers

- In fiscal 2022, about 10,500 Michigan Lottery retailers earned over \$356 million in commissions.
- 842 retailers sold more than \$1 million in Lottery products in FY22.

Helping From The Beginning

- More than \$27 billion raised for Michigan schools since 1972.
- More than \$49 billion in prizes to players since 1972.
- More than \$5.8 billion paid to retailers since 1972.
- The largest jackpot won in Michigan Lottery history was \$1.05 billion in 2021.
