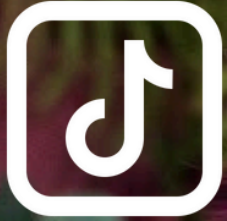

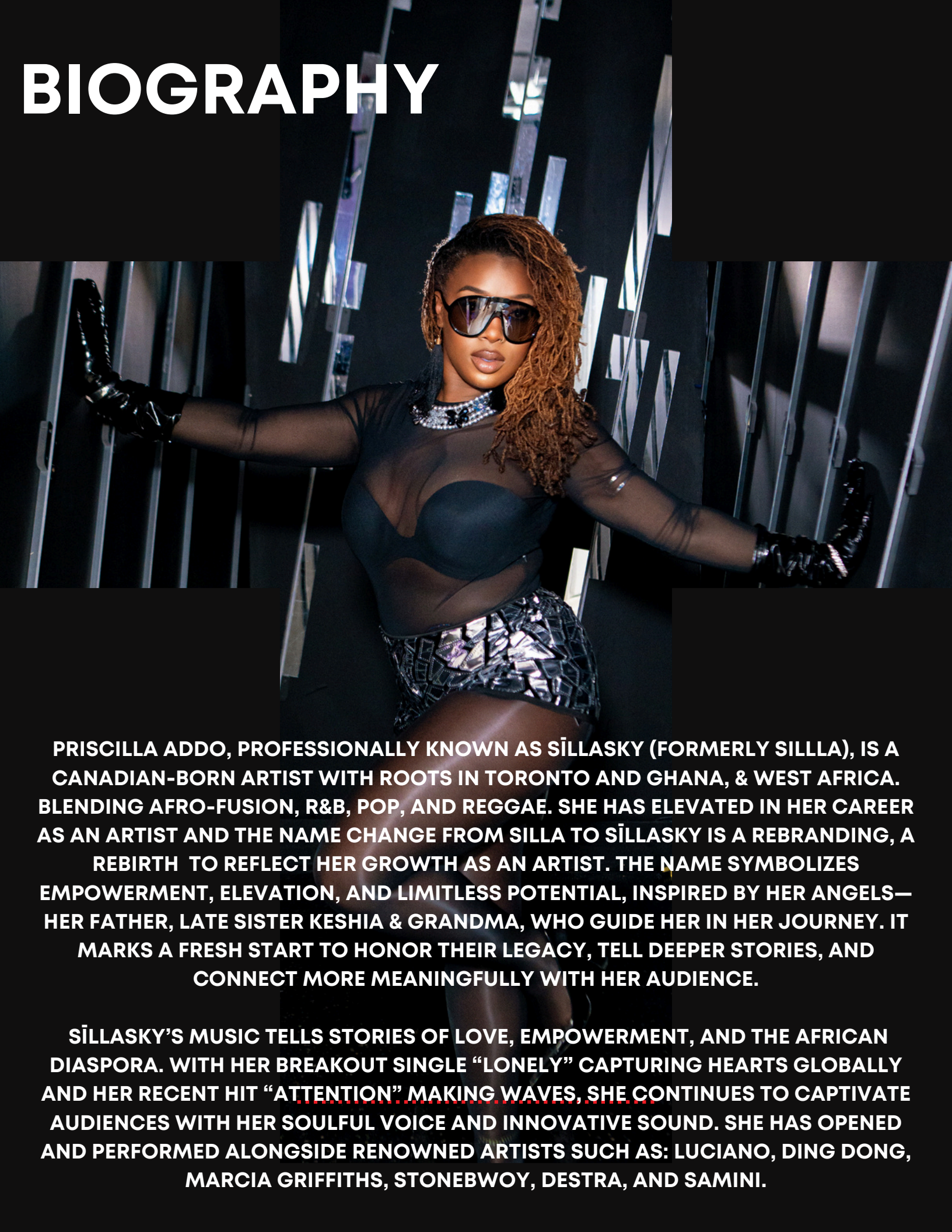

BIOGRAPHY



PRISCILLA ADDO, PROFESSIONALLY KNOWN AS SĪLLASKY (FORMERLY SILLLA), IS A CANADIAN-BORN ARTIST WITH ROOTS IN TORONTO AND GHANA, & WEST AFRICA. BLENDING AFRO-FUSION, R&B, POP, AND REGGAE. SHE HAS ELEVATED IN HER CAREER AS AN ARTIST AND THE NAME CHANGE FROM SILLA TO SĪLLASKY IS A REBRANDING, A REBIRTH TO REFLECT HER GROWTH AS AN ARTIST. THE NAME SYMBOLIZES EMPOWERMENT, ELEVATION, AND LIMITLESS POTENTIAL, INSPIRED BY HER ANGELS—HER FATHER, LATE SISTER KESHIA & GRANDMA, WHO GUIDE HER IN HER JOURNEY. IT MARKS A FRESH START TO HONOR THEIR LEGACY, TELL DEEPER STORIES, AND CONNECT MORE MEANINGFULLY WITH HER AUDIENCE.

SĪLLASKY'S MUSIC TELLS STORIES OF LOVE, EMPOWERMENT, AND THE AFRICAN DIASPORA. WITH HER BREAKOUT SINGLE "LONELY" CAPTURING HEARTS GLOBALLY AND HER RECENT HIT "ATTENTION" MAKING WAVES, SHE CONTINUES TO CAPTIVATE AUDIENCES WITH HER SOULFUL VOICE AND INNOVATIVE SOUND.
