How to Up-cycle a Hoodie: A Guide By Glitter Cymru

Materials:

Two Same size hoodies (different colours)

2 x Shoe laces. 63 inches (150cm)

Sandpaper

Scissors

FIRST STEP

You need to decide which part of the Hoodie you would like to keep. Sometimes the logo may not be right or one side of the hoodie would be more damaged the other one, so this part could be discarded. Make sure to take into account how you would like the hoodie to look like at the end.






STEP TWO




After you have decided which side of the hoodie you are going to keep, go ahead and draw a line in the middle of the hoodie and use scissors to cut it through (Make sure to have assistance if you don't know how to handle scissors, or that you are accompanied by an adult). Make sure to follow the line and use a sharp scissors to make a lean cut.

STEP FOUR

Measure up the length of the Hoodie and divide it by the number of holes you are going to cut open. The resulting measurement will be the distance between each hole (back and front).





To cut the holes open, fold the edge of the hoodie and cut a small circle.

Use sandpaper to smooth the hem and the holes to prevent them from getting messy.

STEP FIVE



Use the shoelaces to connect both sides (use one shoelace for the back and the other for the front).



Your hoodie is ready to wear.
