#### **Judging Overview/Criteria**

#### **The Judging Process**

The 2021 RH MLK Observance Committee Scholarship Pageant judging system was designed to recognize individuality and achievement and encourage community involvement among all contestants.

Judges will be provided with detailed written rules and regulations.

There will be a panel of judges scoring the individual contestants immediately after each competition category. Following the judges scoring, an independent group will tally the scores.

Judges will be selected by the RH MLK Scholarship Committee. Persons familiar with, or related to, any contestant will not serve on the panel of judges.

#### **COMPETITION CATEGORIES**

**Formal Wear**: The formal wear category is designed for the judges to assess the contestant's poise, grace and commanding stage presence. Contestants must follow the required attire.

**Talent:** Talent may be anything you choose that does not cause any health, fire or safety hazards to the audience or damage to the facility. **Also talent must not include in derogative language, nudity or suggestive dancing.** Talent must be limited to 3 minutes; talent over 3 minutes is subject to a penalty. Background music must be sent electronically at least 2 weeks before the Pageant.

**Oratorical Question**: Each contestant will speak on the following topic "How has Dr. King's legacy taught you to embrace your community? Response is limited to 3 minutes, response over 3 minutes is subject to a penalty.

#### Also, scoring will include

- Originality
- Individuality
- Enthusiasm
- Creativity
- On-stage awareness (Poise/ Stage Presentation)
- Appearance

#### **RH MLK Pageant Attire**

The RH MLK Pageant is a very elegant occasion, and your attire should reflect that.

#### **Participants**

- All female participants will wear a formal evening gowns in the color of their choice (including white).
- Male participants will wear a suite or tuxedo in the color of their choice
- While the participant may select their gown, exposed midriff or low cut gowns are not permitted.

#### For Workshops and Rehearsals, Participants

• Casual attire may be worn to rehearsals, and to community service activities.



#### **Financial Responsibility**

The participant raising the most money in each age category (i.e., donations, and other fundraisers) will be crowned Miss & Mr. RH MLK, Junior Miss & Mr. RH MLK, and Little Miss & Mr. RH MLK, respectively. The winning contestant in each age category will receive 10% of the funds they raised in the form of a scholarship or savings bond. The winner of Miss and & Mr MLK may also receive additional scholarship money from the committee the amount will be determined by the MLK Observance Parade Committee budget. In addition all the winners will participate in 4<sup>th</sup> RH MLK Parade. All participants who raise a minimum of \$250.00 will receive a certificate. Winners from competition categories(Best Formal Wear, Best Talent, Best Oratorical Award) will be awarded prizes.

All funds are to be raised in a lawful/legal manner (i.e., ticket sales, bake sales, car washes, yard sales, etc.). The Committee must be notified of all fundraising events. Any flyers, press, social media, or publications regarding events must be submitted to the RH MLK Pageant Committee for approval .

All monies raised in the name of RH MLK Observance Committee must be turned over to the committee via the Treasure or designee of the RH MLK Observance Committee In the event you no longer would like to participate, you must still adhere to this rule. We will **ONLY** take payment via PayPal from the participant's parent that will be turning in the fees for the participant. FRIENDS AND FAMILY OF THE PARTICIPANT <u>MAY NOT</u> SEND INDIVIDUAL PAYMENTS TO THE PAYPAL ACCOUNT, however they may however send it to the PO BOX.

When submitting to the PayPal account you must select the "Friends and Family" option, or you will be charged a fee. Also, when submitting any payments put in the NOTES exactly what you are paying for and which contestant the money is going towards. A note is also required when submitting payments through the PO Box.

The final deadline for all money will be Wednesday, December 1, 2021. Funds should be submitted in the form of checks, money orders, or cash in US currency.

Designated times and locations will be provided to collect all monies. These dates will allow you to avoid holding checks and large sums of money.

All required forms should be filled out completely and accurately. Participant's name must appear on the memo line of all checks to ensure proper processing and credit. All checks should be made payable to RH MLK Observance Committee.
