Entrants Guidelines

Rules & Regulations:

- All applicants must complete the Entry Form and agree to the rules and Hold Harmless Agreement
- Monday, January 3, 2022 is the cutoff date for parade applications and fee of \$35.00 NO EXCEPTIONS
- Only road legal cars will be allowed and two entry per organization.
- You are required to provide your own vehicle
- All vehicles must be able to go at least 5 mph
- Everyone driving a vehicle must wear seat belt and maintain proper distance
- Participants cannot throw candy from cars, candy must be passed out and not thrown.
- Participants may decorate their vehicles (be careful they will not come off at higher rates of speed).
- Walkers are permitted.
- **Vehicle's line-up: 8:30 - 9:15am (a committee member will direct you to your designated spot)**
- **ALL participants must be in line up NO LATER THAN 9:20am**
- You may not disembark from your vehicle until after the parade ends at City Hall & Cedar Street, as well as all side streets within this area. Please Park at the Elementary and Primary School designated parking areas located on Frances Meeks Way.
