Our coalition simply wants peace and health for our neighbors and supports RESPONSIBLE development. Paradise Valley is not responsible. We reject the use of a treatment plant to eject waste water into Mill Bayou and we reject the unprecedented and unregulated stormwater that has been flooding Roland Cutoff Road. Many violations have been uncovered by our team and we are providing a local SERVICE and exercising our civic DUTY by helping to make the processes better through working with our county, state, and federal agencies. We are grateful to receive broad support from this community and beyond and ask for your prayers especially.

By way of a closing statement we understand this is a complicated topic and for those not attending meetings it might be difficult to know what is happening and what drives us. These high density leap-frog developments introduce waste water treatment plants for areas that have no infrastructure (sewage pipes in this case) to support it. These developments introduce storm water flooding that this community is currently experiencing. We call for responsible development in our rural area that eliminates both for ALL our neighbors from ALL walks of life. We are holding developers accountable by expecting the law and processes in place be followed and this is something everyone can hopefully appreciate.
