AFFORDABLE AUTOMATION FOR ENGINEERED COMPOSITE STRUCTURES

ABSTRACT: Imagine a perfect world where you could build the optimum structure for a given application. You would use composite materials for their outstanding properties and orient the fibers along structural load paths to maximize these properties. Your computer would automatically generate these paths and download them to a robot that would "draw" the structure onto a mold surface. Seem far-fetched? Welcome to the world of Automated Fiber Placement (AFP) and Automated Tape Laying (ATL). Now imagine that the part was complete when the last strip was placed, without the need to bag or autoclave the structure. Welcome to the world of thermoplastic composite structures. Further. imagine that you could have AFP or ATL equipment for thermoset or thermoplastic composites "right sized" for your application at an affordable price. Welcome to Automated Dynamics. This presentation will help you to Build Smarter through the understanding of AFP, ATL & thermoplastic composite structures.


