



41ST INTERNATIONAL SAMPE TECHNICAL CONFERENCE SAMPE 2009 – WICHITA

New Jersey SAMPE will be the major sponsor of the ISTC to be held in Wichita in September 2009. The Wichita SAMPE chapter will team with us and be the minor sponsor. With the conference only 11 months away, we're already very busy organizing the technical program and other events surrounding the conference. Here's an overview of where we are 11 months out.

Technical Program - We have about 39 confirmed sessions (that means 39 session titles `with a chair for each). Session titles range from Advanced Manufacturing Technology to Thermoplastic Composites. Session chairs from the NJ chapter include Borys Schafran, Kurt Feichtinger and Carl Zweben. Technical Tracks include General Aviation, Building Blocks, Manufacturing, Nanotechnology and Systems. (All the sessions will fit into one of the tracks.) The Call for Papers is being modified to match the sessions and then we start beating the bushes for Abstracts which are due in early January. You will note that conspicuously absent from the session subject matter are areas such as Infrastructure, Sporting Goods, Medical, etc where the interest is limited anyway. Because the conference locale is Wichita, the General Aviation capital of the world, we have purposely concentrated on A/A related sessions.

Panels - Panels have presentations without formal papers published. We have 8 proposed panels but only 3 of them have been confirmed. Subjects include commercial and military applications, Multiscale Modeling, Carbon Fiber Supply and Energy for Aviation. These should get firmed up by December. There also may be two workshops, one sponsored by the FAA and the other chaired by Dr. Russ Maguire of Boeing and related to Advances in Fiber Technology.

Keynote - Our primary target is the President of Spirit Aerosystems. We are working on that.

Tour -There appears to be 3 choices for a single tour: Spirit Aerosystems, NIAR (National Institute for Aviation Research) at Wichita State Univ, and Cessna Aircraft. Attendees will identify their choice, space permitting


