### **SEPTEMBER MEETING**



# IMPROVED PERFORMANCE OF POLYARYL ETHER AMIDE MATRIX RESINS

### **ABSTRACT:**

A new generation of single-component, room-temperature-stable polyaryl ether amide thermoset matrix resins was introduced to the aerospace and electronics industries within the past year. Promising mechanical properties were obtained with this technology. Recent developments led to the discovery of enhanced long-term stability, particularly for hot/wet conditions, while maintaining critical characteristics including glass transition (Tg) and flame-smoke-toxicity (FST) performance. In addition, ease of processing was addressed to lower curing temperatures. An update will be presented with relevance toward fiber-reinforced composite materials.

Borys Schafran presently serves as Director, Marketing & Business Development, Industrial Chemicals for Evonik Degussa Corporation, Parsippany, NJ.
