A COMPOSITE BLADE FOR A LARGE SCALE CENTRIPAL FAN


ABSTRACT:

A unique process that combines resin transfer molding (RTM) and a collapsible mandrel was used to create a 3 dimensional hollow airfoil with a monolithic skin / spar structure made completely of carbon fiber and epoxy. The use of a collapsible mandrel, allowed internal features to be created with nearly prepreg fiber and resin consolidation, dimensional conformity and strength without the use of an autoclave or high temperature processing. To close the open airfoil end, RTM carbon fiber and epoxy end caps were manufactured. These end caps were structurally bonded and riveted in place. Bespoke titanium inserts were bonded into the blade ends. The resultant carbon fiber components were approximately 50% lighter than its metallic counterparts they are slated to replace. The components were tested in shear, bending and as a blade extraction from the parent structure. The components exceeded the design parameters with little failure. The early testing program showed the blades were very robust and likely damage tolerant enough for continuous service.

BIOGRAPHY:

Russ Shaffer is the Director of Engineering for Curtiss Wright Flow Control Engineered Pump Division (formerly known as Flowserve Government Marine Business Unit (GMBU), Ingersoll Dresser Pump and Ingersoll-Rand), with responsibility for new product development. He has been with the company for over 24 years with experience in rotating equipment design and development, foundry operations and for the last 16 plus years a primary focus on Composite Material Application and Development. He received a Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Pittsburgh and a Masters Degree in Engineering from Lehigh University.

Anthony Turchi is currently the senior composites engineer for Curtiss Wright Flow Control Engineered Pump Division (formerly known as Flowserve Government Marine Business Unit (GMBU), Ingersoll Dresser Pump and Ingersoll-Rand). His focus is the development and production of composite parts for critical naval rotating equipment. His previous work has been in the areas of composite manufacturing, composites for aerospace, industrial composite applications, and race car engineering. Mr. Turchi holds a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering and a minor in Business Administration.


NEW JERSEY SAMPE CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP




