

Brad Pilcher (b. 2001) is an Atlanta-area clarinetist studying under renowned clarinet performer and educator Dr. Deborah Bish. He is currently making appearances in the Florida State University Wind Orchestra. In the past, he has performed with the Schwob Wind Ensemble and Philharmonic as a rotating soprano, bass, and contrabass clarinet player, the St. Luke United Methodist Church Wind Orchestra, the Atlanta Wind Project, and the Georgia Philharmonic, on top of making appearances in film music and various chamber ensembles. Brad has performed in venues such as Atlanta Symphony Hall, the Birmingham Museum of Art, Legacy Hall (Columbus GA), and Ruby Diamond Concert Hall (Tallahassee).

He previously studied under the guidance of Dr. James Ogburn.
