2024 Scholarship Program

Chios Societies of the Americas and Canada (CSAC) will be awarding up to four \$1,000 scholarships “In Memory of Dimitrios Bouboulis” to recognize and reward students of Chian descent who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance and exhibited a love of their Hellenic and Chian heritage.

Students must meet the following criteria to submit their application:

- Must be of Chian descent.
- They, a parent, or grandparent must be a member in good standing of one of the member societies of CSAC.
- Must have a minimum grade point average of B.
- Must be in their final year of high school and/or enrolled in a college or university undergraduate or graduate program in the Fall of 2024. (Proof of enrollment is required prior to release of scholarship award.)

Completed application packages must be submitted along with the following no later than June 15th, 2024.

Application package includes the following:

- Completed Application Form
- Most recent official or unofficial transcript from high school, college, or university.
- Personal Essay up to 500 words including a brief description of yourself, your goal(s) and aspirations after graduation, motivation for applying for the scholarship, connection with Chian and Hellenic culture and how you may participate in the United Chios Societies of Americas and Canada
- Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, academic advisor from school, community leader, priest, etc.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed and evaluated by a panel of judges and measured by the following criteria:

- Strength of their academic record.
- Recommendation letter
- Personal Essay
