- **Two letters of recommendation should be submitted** directly to the chiosdcscholarship@gmail.com email on your behalf from one of the following: your local priest, a teacher/professor, an academic advisor, a community leader that has known you for a minimum of two years, an officer from a non-profit organization where you have been a volunteer.
- **Attach a Resume or CV:** include school and extracurricular activities with your application
- **Academic Transcript:** Request an academic transcript from your high school (if you are currently a high school senior) or your college/university, technical or trade school. The transcript must come directly from the institution that you are attending and emailed to chiosdcscholarship@gmail.com
