- The applicant must be a full-time student at an accredited institution, a 2024 high school graduate, or a current college student or a graduate student
- Be the child or grandchild of a paid member of the Chios Society of the Greater Washington, DC Area for 2023 and 2024
- Have a cumulative minimum GPA 3.0

- <u>**Two letters of recommendation should be submitted**</u> directly to the <u>scholarship@chios2024dc.org</u> email on your behalf from one of the following: your local priest, a teacher/professor, an academic advisor, a community leader that has known you for a minimum of two years, an officer from a non-profit organization where you have been a volunteer.
- <u>Attach a Resume or CV</u>: include school and extracurricular activities with your application
- <u>Academic Transcript:</u> Request an academic transcript from your high school (if you are currently a high school senior) or your college/university, technical or trade school. The transcript must come directly from the institution that you are attending and emailed to <u>scholarship@chios2024dc.org</u>

#### Application Deadline: June 25, 2024, by 11:59 EST Applications received after this date will not be accepted

- Please note that scholarship awards are not guaranteed to any applicant.
- Scholarship awards may be awarded a maximum of (2) times per applicant
- One scholarship will be awarded per family per year
- Winners will be notified by mail by the end of September. The winners will be announced at the 67<sup>th</sup> National Convention in Washington, DC on October 12<sup>th</sup> the evening of the Gala. Winners are encouraged to attend to receive their award.
