Video 1: Experimental Short Films

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course introduces students to contemporary video at the intersection of art, culture, and internet memes. Through hands-on experience, students will learn to operate digital video cameras, edit with Premiere Pro, and navigate the full production process—from scriptwriting and storyboarding to shooting, editing, and festival submissions. Emphasizing experimentation and personal voice, the course explores a range of video formats, including short films, experimental video, and meme culture. Discussions and screenings of contemporary artists and filmmakers will provide historical and conceptual context, while technical workshops will equip students with the skills to bring their ideas to life. No prior experience is required.

This course will be broken down into four sections and three video projects; 1) a single scene short film, 2) a narrative after drunk history, & 3) an experimental final project.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon successful completion of this course students will:

- Understand the relationship between contemporary art and culture
- Integrate traditional and unconventional filmmaking techniques
- Utilize digital editing software
- Understand how to operate a digital video camera with proper lighting
- Navigate and apply to film festivals on Film Freeway
