<u>Ecological Restoration Project Kirvin Park – Randy Toth</u>

After an article in the Berkshire Eagle about the restoration and preservation of wetlands in Kirvin Park and the fact that our snowmobile trail along with the city's hiking trail goes thru the same area, I contacted Pittsfield's park, open space and natural resource program manager to be sure our trail would not be impacted. He responded in writing that:

"The bridge and the trail running south are the western edge of the project. There will be a temp fence alongside the trail separating the project from the trail. Trail remains open for walking in summer, and snowmobiles in winter."

Follow Up from Randy to the restoration project manager

"I couldn't find the local trail system that utilizes Kirvin Pak for hiking, mountain biking, snowmobiling, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing on your published maps outlining the Kirvin Park Wetlands Restoration. I just wanted to be sure you were aware of this valuable trail system. The local Snowmobile Club (Berkshire Snow Seekers), which has legal access through the park to access October Mountain State Forest, not only grooms this trail in the winter; but has also donated a complete bridge across Ashley Brook to the city for use by all."

Stay tuned and kudos to Randy for staying on top of this very importing issue.

Time to start thinking about?

It is that time of year (early September) to start thinking about trail work. Snowmobile clubs and volunteers typically perform trail maintenance in the fall, before the first snow, to prepare for the riding season. Here are just a few of the preseason trail maintenance tasks. As a BSS member ask yourself what you can do to make these trails even better.

Volunteers spend a lot of time and energy clearing, repairing, and marking trails with signs during the offseason. Here's what that work often includes:

- Removing downed trees and limbs: Volunteers patrol the trail system with chainsaws and cutting tools to clear hazards left by storms and mother nature.
- Cutting back brush: Trimming back brush and clearing overgrown sections helps to widen the trails and keeps branches from obscuring riders' views.
- Removing debris and rocks: Clearing rocks, roots, and other debris creates a smoother and safer trail bed. A smooth trail base before the first snowfall makes for a better groomed trail all season long.
- Updating signage: Old, faded, or damaged signs are replaced to ensure riders can easily navigate the trail system and are aware of any dangers.
- Repairing infrastructure: Any needed repairs to bridges, culverts, or trail markers are completed before the ground freezes.
- Contacting landowners: Clubs confirm access with the private landowners who generously allow snowmobile trails to cross their property.




