CHILDCARE AWARE / ARMY FEE ASSISTANCE

The Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood (MCCYN) program supports eligible families with childcare if they cannot access military-based care due to distance or a waitlist. The Army Fee Assistance program under the MCCYN program provides fee assistance to eligible Army families to offset the cost of community-based care. For example, if you live or work far from an existing military installation, your family may be eligible for child care fee assistance.

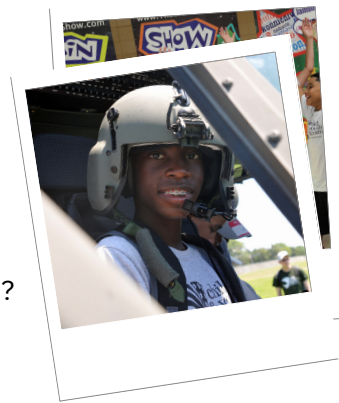
