

Carpenter Ant Treatment Prep Sheet

For best results, follow the preparation instructions below. Skipping steps may prevent proper control of pest activity.

Carpenter ant activity can be a nuisance, making colonies in and around customer's homes. They are attracted to soft and weather-damaged wood, organic debris, and food waste.They thrive around heavy foliage around exterior areas and typically exist in large numbers.Treatment is most effective when applied to both interior and exterior perimeters in the same service timeframe.

<u>Step #1:</u> Remove all clutter, food debris, and standing water from all areas and surfaces prior to service, and on a regular basis.

Step #2: Pull all furniture away from the walls to make baseboard perimeters accessible on all levels.

<u>Step #3:</u> Remove all items stored around or touching the exterior perimeter, including foliage and wood piles.

<u>Step #4:</u> If activity has been observed in or around cupboard areas, please remove items for effective spray coverage.

<u>Please note</u>: If a spray treatment is being done to the interior areas, all pets and people must vacate for 4-6 hours.
