Non-Affiliation with External Organizations

 The program operates independently from All Star gyms, high schools, and postsecondary institutions, ensuring that students' participation does not conflict with other cheerleading commitments.

No Requirement for External Practice or Coaching Hours

 Students are not mandated to attend external practices or events at outside organizations, allowing them to complete the program entirely online

Flexible Scheduling

 The self-paced nature of the courses allows students to manage their time effectively, accommodating their own schedules. Required course work is not designed around a certain program or team, but instead set by the student themselves.

Student Information Protection

 Student data is never shared with coaches, gyms, or outside organizations. Personal information is kept strictly confidential and is in accordance FIOPPA policies.

No Recruiting or Promotions

 The program does not engage in recruiting or promoting any gyms, teams, or external organizations. Students will not be contacted for external opportunities through this program. Students and coaches are encouraged to refrain from sharing program affiliation when possible.

Neutral Course Environment

 Courses are completely free from references, mentions, or endorsements of any gym or affiliation to maintain a neutral and we are committed to doing out best to create an unbiased learning environment.
